



OGDEN CANYON AND SURROUNDING AREA

Ogden Canyon is the northern-most canyon covered in this guide. A popular outdoor recreation area during all seasons, Ogden Canyon holds ski resorts, ice climbs, mountain biking trails, a reservoir for water recreation, and of course—snowshoe trails.

A note for future reference: Snowbasin Ski Resort has future plans for developing a cross-country and snowshoe park. When this takes place there may be changes in fees and trailheads accessed through the Snowbasin area. This chapter includes routes in Ogden Canyon, outlying routes access through Ogden Canyon, such as the North Park area, and routes accessed through Snowbasin Ski Resort which is accessed through Ogden or Weber Canyons.

Warm Ups: The Oaks, a canyon diner, sits 5 miles up S.R. 39/Ogden Canyon. A burger will run you \$7 with cobbler ala-mode at \$4. There is a full menu of mountain munchies. The ambiance of a mountain diner is a plus.
